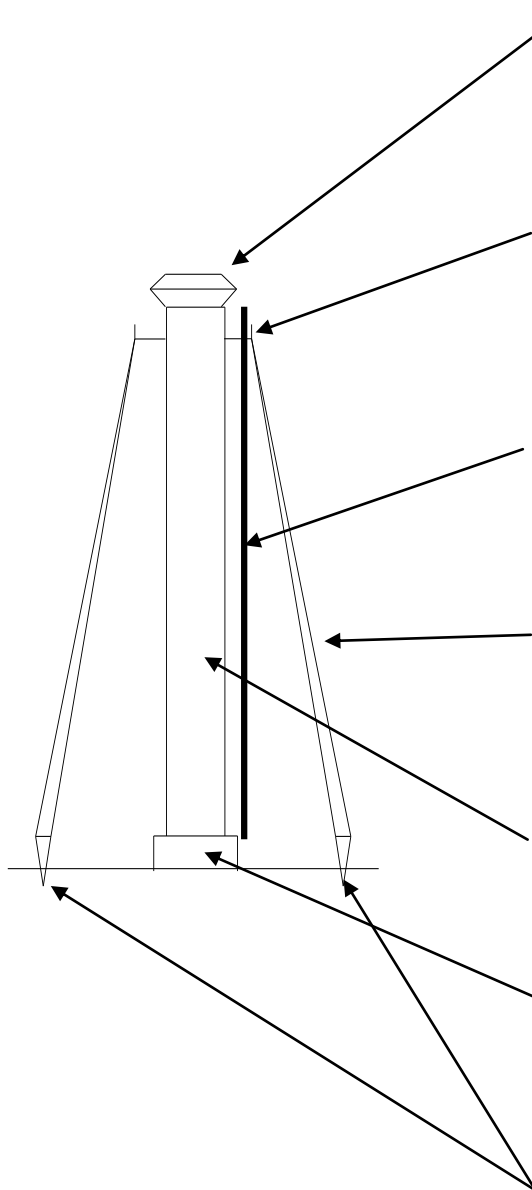


THE COURTYARD PILLAR



Wooden Chapter Overlaid with Silver (Redemption)

The wood represents the Lord's humanity, which provided redemption, He as the Head (chapter), provided it to the rest of the pillar (believers). On His perfect humanity that provided this redemption was placed a crown of glory and honor.

Silver (Redemption) hooks used to hold the Silver (Redemption) Rods joining each Pillar. They were also used to hold the Linen Curtain and Cords

Through our Lord's sacrifice on the cross came the redemptive silver hook on which perfect righteousness hangs on.

Curtain of Finely Twisted Linen (perfect righteousness)

This perfect righteousness is what is credited to all believers in the Lord Jesus Christ. The fact that it was 5 (grace) cubits high reflects that it was the work of God's grace.

Cords made of Finely Twisted Linen (Perfect Righteousness), as well as with Blue (Heavenly Origin), Purple (Royalty) and Scarlet (Sacrificial Work) Yarn

In this, we see that judgement was linked to redemption with the cord. This cord is the Lord Jesus Christ and it is He who also gives us stability to stand upright in the winds of the trials of this life.

Pillar of Shittum Wood (Humanity)

Our Lord's uncorrupted humanity is seen here, as well as all believers. Since He is the Head that provided redemption, He is also the portion of the pillar that is overlaid with silver.

Brass (Judgement) Socket Base

This base speaks of the judgement that all humanity sits on, but through our Lord, there is a link to redemption. It is because of the redemptive work that our Lord's heel (humanity) was bruised by this judgement.

Brass (Judgement) Pins that were driven into the Ground
